

AWT's 2015 Annual Network Conference was based on Isaiah 52:1.

This year's conference entitled "Selfie" aimed to help the woman to understand herself, and therefore be equipped to confront the challenges she faces as a result of her upbringing and the society. Fifty-five women from 12 countries attended our eleventh conference held in November. Countries included: Jordan, Egypt, Lebanon, UAE, Kuwait, KSA, Syria, Iraq, Palestine, Israel, Sweden and the USA. Two keynote speakers from Egypt and Jordan covered spiritual, psychological and social issues.

This year, we had two groups from Florida and Texas who came from USA to pamper our women with love, prayers and massages. What a blessing to be united in Christ, exchange experience and encouragement with one another.










- We praise God for you, our friend and partner in ministry. You've been faithful thus far in your prayers and support to us. Thank you
